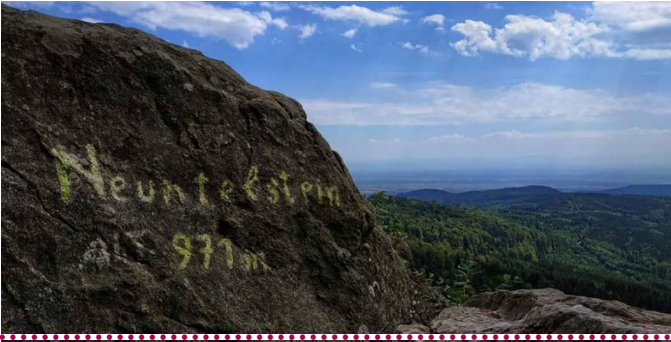


HIKE TO THE NEUNTELSTEIN ROCK FROM THE HOHWALD

Discover the Northern slope of the Andlau valley and its imposing summit, the Neuntelstein, thanks to the fantastic work of signposting carried out by the Vosges clubs of Barr and Le Hohwald. This granite rock peaks at 971 metres and offers sumptuous views of the Mont Sainte-Odile slope, the Alsace plain, the Black Forest and, on a clear day, the Alps.

USEFUL INFORMATION

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STEPS

1 On your way to Welschbruch

When you leave the Tourist Office, walk up Rue Sainte-Odile. After the Catholic church, follow the small path opposite that leads up into the forest. At the end of the forest, cross the D426.

2 Off to the Neuntelstein peak

As you leave the forest, go straight ahead at the roundabout. Then turn immediately left towards the Maison forestière du Welschbruch. After the barrier, cross the D130 and take the footpath heading uphill. After 200 m, there is a clearing offering a beautiful view of the southern slope of the Andlau valley. Take the bridge over the Kirneck, cross the D130 and continue straight ahead (additional option 1: just before Neuntelstein, you can see the source of river Kirneck; 15 minutes (two ways). Arrival on the Neuntelstein plateau (2 picnic tables and a Club Vosgien shelter provided). Please note: access to the rock is not secure.

Additional option: From Neuntelstein, follow the yellow triangle to Rothlach and its inn (1 hour (two ways)).

4 Way back to the village

With your back to the Neuntelstein shelter, turn left towards Le Hohwald. Cross the D 130 and continue straight ahead. After passing through a wooded area, cross the forest road and continue straight ahead. Cross the forestry road “Grande Ceinture”, then turn immediately left. When you reach the road leading out of the forest, turn right into the Parc du séquoia with its ornamental arboretum. After visiting the park, head for the Catholic church at the end of the road. Turn right at the church, then left into Rue Principale.
