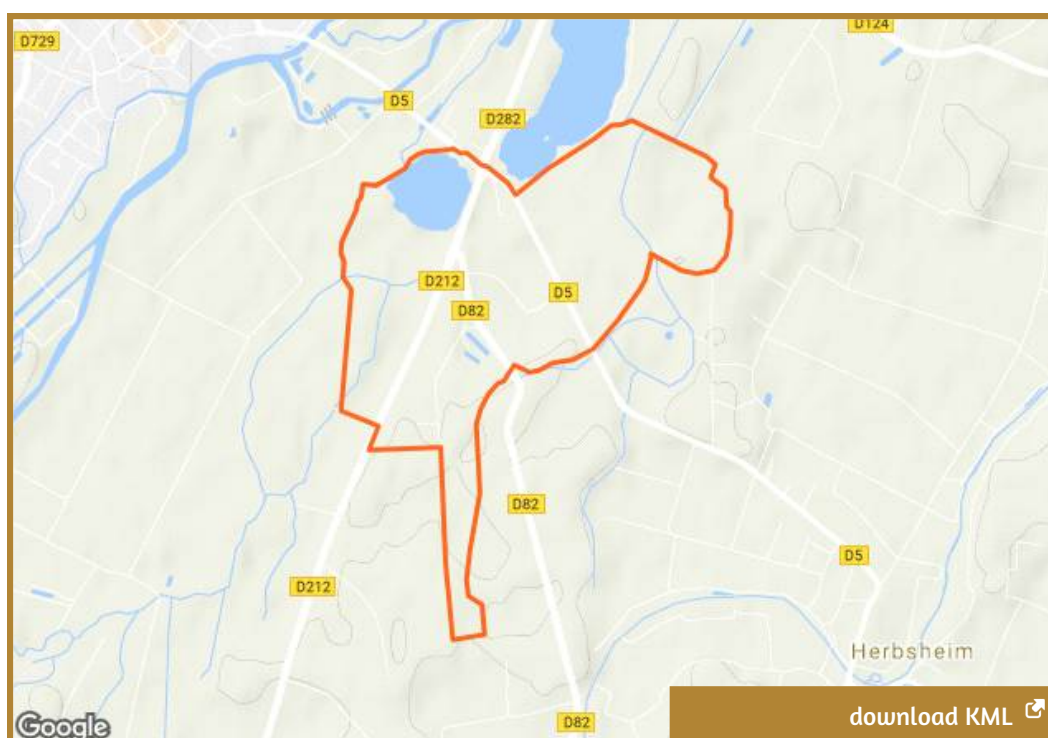

Quarry

This quarry was developed on the historic site of Helvetum.

Gravel is extracted directly from the groundwater level.

Gravel extraction is highly regulated and must be performed with great care due to the gravel's direct contact with the groundwater and to avoid damaging the environment.
