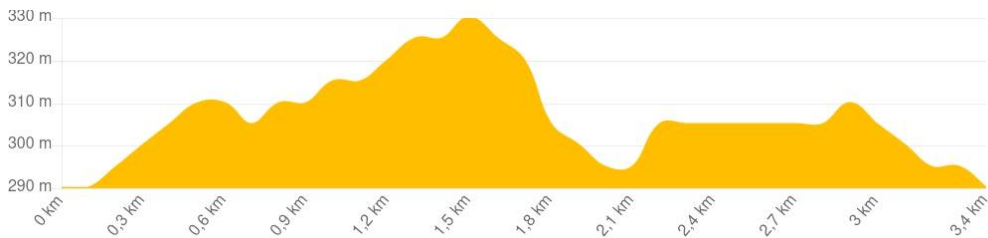

STEPS

1 Departure

Once you have parked in the "Cave du Vieil Armand" car park, you can enjoy the general information given on the first explanatory panel, opposite the road.

2 Premiers ceps

Cross the road and you'll see a sign introducing you to the Alsatian vineyards and one of the seven grape varieties. You will then come across the first vines on your right, while on your left is the Brucker cellar. The path then veers slightly to the left, taking you through the vineyards. A few houses are visible further on. After the houses, turn left at the 5th signpost.

3 Intersection en Y

A little further on, a sign indicates the direction from which you came. Don't pay any attention to it: it's for walkers finishing their walk. Descend to the right and you will come to a Y-shaped junction. There are two signs, back to back, in front of you. Continue along the path on the right. There are two benches where you can enjoy the panoramic view: Hartmannswiller, its 15th-century fortified cemetery and its medieval castle, both listed historic monuments, in front of you below; Berrwiller on the right, the Alsace plain and the Black Forest in the background (in fine weather).

4 Intersection en T

The path continues slightly uphill, almost in a straight line, until it reaches the 9th signpost. The path then turns right at an angle before leading you left after a T-junction.

5 **Domaine d'Ollwiller**

At the 10th signpost, turn left to continue along the path, which takes you down a steep grassy slope. In front of you, you can admire the Domaine d'Ollwiller and its castle. The 11th explanatory panel will tell you more about them. Then turn left, following the Domaine d'Ollwiller for three panels. A 180° panorama awaits you: the Black Forest, the Alsace Plain, the villages of Hartmannswiller and Berrwiller, and the Domaine d'Ollwiller.

6 **Arrival**

At the 14th sign, turn left into a steep climb. At the end of the climb, turn right. You now continue straight on until you come to the "Y" junction again, where there are benches and the last sign for the wine trail. Go back to the Cave du Vieil Armand and follow the path you took at the beginning.
