

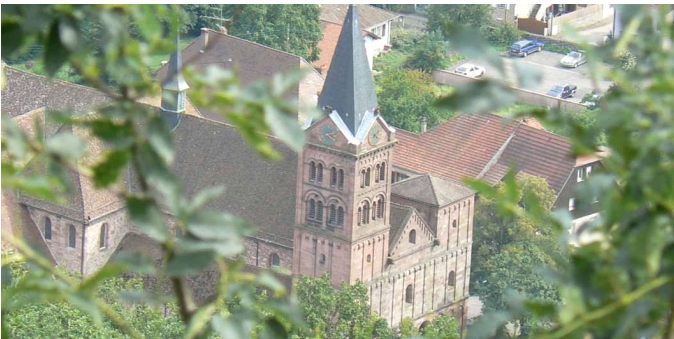
HIKING TRAIL: THE DEVIL'S CAULDRON LAUTENBACH

STEPS

1 **Departure** ▲

From the car park on the right, opposite the Vivarium du Moulin, at the junction of the D430 and D429 in the direction of Le Markstein, take the tarmac road that turns right above the water reservoir and becomes a forest track through the Saegefelsen and Erlenbach massifs. The entire route is signposted with a red triangle.

2 **Devil's Cauldron** ▲

At the Chaudron du Diable or Teufelskessel there is a magnificent viewpoint over the Florival valley and the Vosges ridges.

3 **Kappellenacker** ▲

At the Chaudron du Diable or Teufelskessel there is a magnificent viewpoint over the Florival valley and the Vosges ridges.

4 **Main street** ▲

Then walk up the main street back to the car park. On the way back, be sure to visit the Romanesque collegiate church, a listed historic monument renowned for its harmonious porch and the "Tilleuls de Lautenbach" from Jean Egen's novel.
