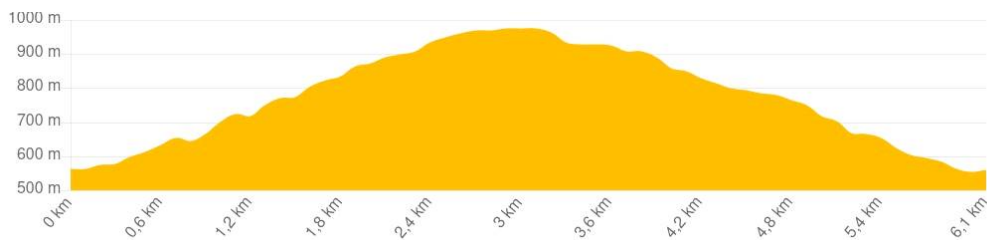

STEPS



Start

Leave your vehicle in the car park at the Rimbach town hall (downhill behind the town hall building).

1 1

En sortant du parking, face à l'Hôtel l'Aigle d'Or, tournez à gauche sur la rue principale. About 200 metres further on, at the crossroads, keep to the right and continue for just under 200m on the Route de la Glashutte. Take the steep path that rises to the right and then, at the fountain, take the path to the left, following the  markings.

At the next junction, take the path that climbs to the right towards the Judenhut (red white red). You begin a tough climb on a path that crosses wider paths twice. You pass a magnificent viewpoint from which you can see the Glashutte farmhouse inn below. Continue along the same path to the Judenhut pass (tables, benches, unsupervised fountain and Club Vosgien shelter).

After a break at the Judenhut, descend a few metres to the crossroads where the various paths and tracks meet. Head in the direction of Murbach and the Langmatt, then immediately turn right onto the red-white-red signposted path towards the Ebeneck. After a few dozen metres at the junction, keep to the right. The narrow, uneven path alternates between short uphill and downhill sections.

After about a kilometre on this path, take the track on the right towards the Ebeneck. direction of Ebeneck, cross a wider path and continue straight ahead under the fir trees. The path again crosses a wider track and then you pass a cow crossing. You are now in the Ebeneck meadow. Don't hesitate to leave the path and go left towards the top of the hill. You'll enjoy a magnificent view of Guebwiller and its vineyards, the surrounding villages, the Alsace plain, the Black Forest and, if the weather is right, the Bernese Alps. As you turn around, you can enjoy a view of the summit of the Grand Ballon, recognisable by its ball-shaped civil aviation radar.

Turn back to the path and continue downhill towards the Munsteraeckerle pass on a path that is almost flat at first but then becomes steeper. When you reach the Munsteraeckerle (tables, benches, small hut), take the narrow path that descends to the right towards the village of Rimbach (red round markers). This narrow, winding path soon leads to the rue de Murbach. Walk down this street to the Hôtel l'Aigle d'Or and Rimbach town hall.
