THE NECROPOLIS IN SIGOLSHEIM

The necropolis is the perfect place to enjoy a view of the Alsatian vineyards, the plain and the surrounding mountains. It is also a listed site that bears witness to the violent fighting of the Second World War.

DEPARTURE: Sigolsheim town hall

MARKINGS: Unmarked route. Follow the instructions on the route.



DESCRIPTION

- 1 Leave the town hall behind and follow the road to Kientzheim on the left (cycle track). Go along the cemetery and the village ramparts. You will arrive at the place 11ème R.C.A.
- 2 Go straight up following the cycle track "l'itinéraire du vignoble". At the first calvary, keep to the left. At the second one, turn right and continue to climb following the road.
- 3 On the way up, take the path on your right marked by the engraving "2008" on the ground. At the top of the path, take the small path on the right at the corner of the stone wall.
- 4 Walk straight ahead to the next crow's feet. Stay on the rightmost path. The path leads to a wider track. Continue up this path until you reach the necropolis, keeping the French flag in sight.
- 5 From the top of the necropolis, go down the stairs to the lower car park marked by the American flag. Take the road on your right which goes down to Sigolsheim. At the bottom, turn into rue Saint-Jacques to find the town hall, your starting point.
