FROM THE PIERRES TREMBLANTES TO THE LINGEKOPF

The perfect hike to experience the mountain landscape in all its glory. Start in a mysterious forest, then plunge into the military past of the First World War before winding through typical highland landscapes.

DEPARTURE: Saint-Urbain church in Orbey

DESCRIPTION

Point of information: the route passes in the immediate vicinity of the Linge Memorial Museum, which is open from mid-April to mid-November.

1 When you leave the church car park, go left and walk up the lane between the two low walls at the corner of the large white house following the blue signpost and then the blue/white/blue rect. to "LES PIERRES TREMBLANTES". At the top after the house, the path enters the forest on your left.

2 At the next crossroads, go straight on (blue rectangle) which leads you to the trembling stones. Continue to the Ferrebeuf crossroads and follow the blue rectangle for a long time until the intersection with the departmental road.

3 Cross the road carefully, going to your right. Follow the small path along the road, then turn left (blue rect.) to the intersection at the Baerenstall cemetery.

4 Cross the road (side of the picnic tables). Follow the yellow signs to the Schratzmaennele. Continue with this signposting to Glasborn, then to the Wettstein Pass. Do not cross the road.

5 Walk along the cemetery. At the end, turn right onto the wide path (yellow ring) that enters the forest. Follow this signposting for a long time until you reach the start intersection at the antennas. Go back down to Orbey on the same path as at the start.
