# FROM KIENTZHEIM TO RIQUEWIHR VIA THE CHÊNE DE LA CHAPELLE

Through forest and vineyard, this pleasant walk leads you to the discovery of Riquewihr. Be prepared to stroll for miles in this typical and colourful village on the Alsace Wine Route.

Please note: the walking time indicated does not include the time spent visiting the village.

## DESCRIPTION

Practical information: for a departure from Kaysersberg, follow the instructions of stage 1 of the hike p.62 and then continue at stage 3.

**1** From the Place du Lieutenant Dutilh, take the road that goes straight up through the vineyards towards Riquewihr (blue cross). At the level of the second calvary, take the wide path which goes up in the forest towards Aubure (blue cross).

**2** Continue on the Streibach path, then the Upper Schwärtz path to the next crossroads, always following the blue cross.

**3** At the next intersection, continue on the path marked with a blue cross, then choose one of the 2 options:

- to pass under the Rocher des Corbeaux go straight on the wide path (blue cross).
- for a panoramic view from the rock, take the small path on your right marked by Touffu, a small tree.

Whatever your choice, after the rock, continue straight on to the Chêne de la Chapelle.

**4** Turn right towards "RIQUEWIHR" (blue triangle). Don't miss the path that bends to the left. Continue until you leave the forest. Continue to the left (blue cross) to reach Riquewihr.

**5** On the way back, retrace your steps and follow the road marked out by the Way of St James/Green Horse to Kientzheim.
