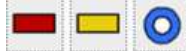

# THE SUMMITS OF GRAND AND PETIT BRÉZOUARD BY THE CASTLE OF LE BONHOMME

During this tour, discover the two peaks of Brézouard in the gentle tranquility that reigns at an altitude of over 1200m. A magnificent route which ends on the mountainside to offer you a picturesque view of the valley and the village of Le Bonhomme.

**DEPARTURE:** parking of the Saint-Nicolas church, Le Bonhomme

## DESCRIPTION

*Point of information: a quiet zone for the protection of the Capercaillie is likely to be put in place prohibiting access to the Grand Brézouard. A diversion will be set up on site to allow you to easily reach the Petit Brézouard.*

- 1 From the church car park, walk along the road and follow the GR5 marked in red to the top of the Col des Bagenelles. At the top, cross the road carefully to the right and continue on the GR5.
- 2 On the Haïcot stubble at the big crossroads, start your ascent to the Grand Brézouard by continuing to follow the GR5.
- 3 Continue to the top of Petit Brézouard. Continue to the next intersection and change to the yellow rect. towards "LE PLAT".
- 4 At the crossroads, continue on the path opposite, following the yellow rect. Be careful to take the right path. Further down, the path leads to a small tarmac road. Go down to the right (yellow rect. / green ring).
- 5 At the next intersection, head towards the castle (blue ring). To climb the ridge, the path winds through the rocks and is not very visible. Be careful on this section. You then reach the castle. Continue to follow the blue ring to reach the village. Walk back up to the church to reach your starting point.
