FROM KAYSERSBERG TO RIBEAUVILLÉ

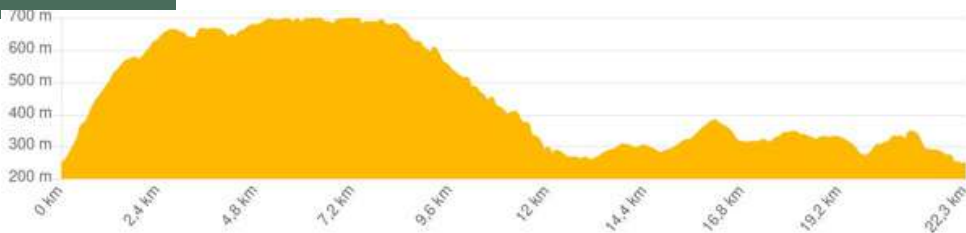

Join the wine-producing towns of Ribeauvillé, Hunawihr and Riquewihr by following the mythical routes of the GR5 and Santiago de Compostela. This route is also an invitation to walk along one of the most beautiful stages of the Alsace Wine Route ... but on foot! Please note: the walking time indicated does not include visits to the various villages.

DEPARTURE: Kaysersberg town hall

DESCRIPTION

Practical information: the route is presented in the form of a loop, but it can be done as a round trip following only the Way of St James.

- From the town hall square, go under the porch. Go up to the castle. Continue up the hill following the blue cross. You will pass the rocher des corbeaux and then the oak tree of the chapel. Continue straight on for several kilometres with the same markings until you reach the intersection with a wide path.
- Turn right towards "BILSTEIN/RIBEAUVILLE". At the next intersection, pay attention, because the blue cross splits into two roads. Ignore the direction "Koenigsstuhl" and continue straight on the road. A few metres further on, you will find the path leading to Ribeauvillé (blue cross).
- Continue to the Seelacker pass then follow the red rect. (GR5) to Ribeauvillé.
- For the return journey, follow the Way of St. James/Green Horse. From the butchers' tower, go up the Grand'Rue and turn into the "rue de la Fontaine" to the top. Cross the road and continue opposite "rue du vignoble". Go straight on until you reach Hunawihr and Riquewihr.
- As you approach Kientzheim, at the calvary, leave the road and turn right, still following Saint-Jacques-de-Compostelle/chevalet vert to Kaysersberg.
