FROM KAYSERSBERG TO AMMERSCHWIHR

An ideal walk for wine lovers. This charming circuit links Kaysersberg to the largest Alsatian wine town, Ammerschwihr, renowned for its great wines, including the Grand Cru du Kaefferkopf. A tasting at a winegrower's will make your walking tour as original as possible!

DEPARTURE: Kaysersberg town hall

DESCRIPTION

- From the Kaysersberg town hall, walk down the main street to the Porte Basse car park. Turn right along the car park, the playground and the cemetery. Carefully cross the RD415 to go up to the St Wolfgang chapel in front of you.
- Follow the red ring. At the next intersection, follow the yellow cross to the Flieger Chapel.
- From the chapel, continue straight on following the yellow signpost. The path ends near the route des Trois Epis. Do not cross. Stay on the signposted path which passes between the vineyards and the river. Follow this path up to the village of Ammerschwihr. Go and explore the wine town freely. When you have finished your visit, return to this intersection (rue du Rempart).
- To return to Kaysersberg, take the route to Santiago de Compostela, also signposted in blue. You first pass above Ammerschwihr through the vineyards and then enter the forest to come out again on the RN415. Cross carefully and reach the town centre of Kaysersberg.
