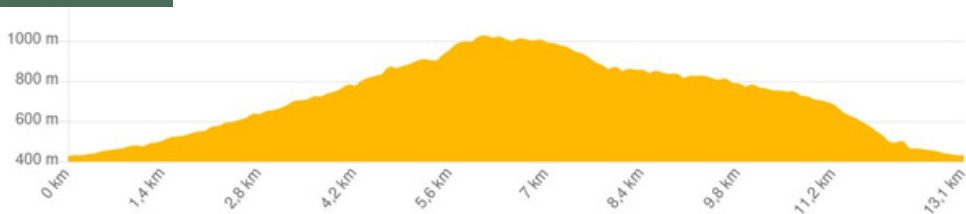

In the heart of the Welche region, this hike invites you to discover a rural area that has always had a strong link with wood and agriculture. By taking a little height, contemplate the landscapes of a rich and splendid nature shaped by the pastures and the large forests.

DEPARTURE: Fréland town hall

DESCRIPTION

- From the town hall, walk up the Grand Rue for a long time. At the bend in the D11 go straight on into the "rue de la fonderie" (red diamond). At the top of the road, at the crossroads, continue to climb the rightmost road following the yellow rhombus and red/white/red rect. direction "VOIRIMONT".
- At the top of the road, at the place called Voirimont, the path comes to an intersection with a tarmac road. Turn right. Walk on this road for 200m and take the path that goes up on the left (green ring).
- At the intersection, ignore the GR5 (red rect.) and take the path to the right. Go straight on until the path leads to a small tarmac road. Continue on the road until you reach the Col de Fréland and its viewpoint.
- Continue until you reach the junction with the D11.3. Without crossing, take the path on the right that follows it below. At the house, keep to the left and follow the small path that runs alongside the road.
- At the calvary, continue downhill following the yellow diamond. At the next crossroads, continue straight down following the red ring to the chapel. Continue downhill until you reach Fréland. Back on the road, go down to the right until the town hall.
