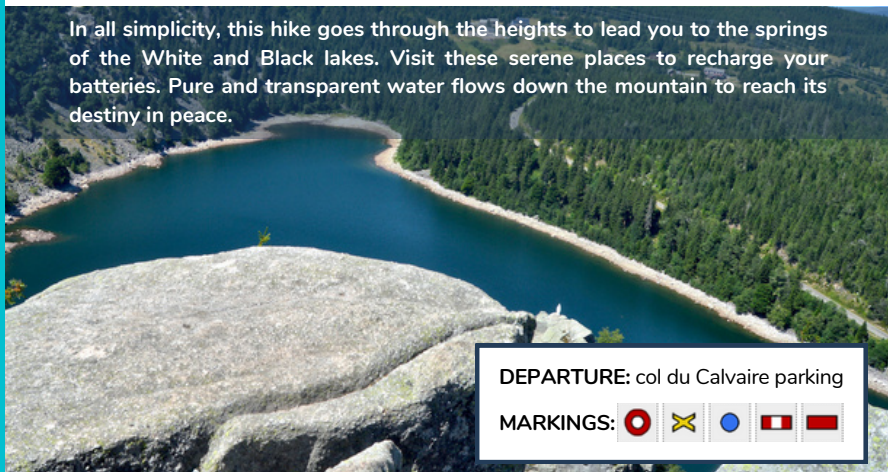

THE SOURCES OF THE LAKES

In all simplicity, this hike goes through the heights to lead you to the springs of the White and Black lakes. Visit these serene places to recharge your batteries. Pure and transparent water flows down the mountain to reach its destiny in peace.



DEPARTURE: col du Calvaire parking

DESCRIPTION

- 1 From the col du Calvaire car park, cross the road carefully to join the small path that enters the forest 50m below. Follow the red rect. / red ring to go up towards the ridge. Higher up, at the level of the crow's feet, take the left path (red ring).
- 2 Walk along the crest of the lake until you reach its source. Continue around it following the path on the left (red ring) until you reach the top of Hans Rock.
- 3 Before the descent of the rock face, take the path on the right (yellow easel) to the Belmont observatory. After a few more meters, the path leads to a wide road. Go up to the right (blue circle) and continue straight along the ridge of the lac Noir which passes by its source.
- 4 At the next intersection, turn right towards the hautes-chaumes (red/white/red rect.) to join the GR5 path.
- 5 Turn right and go straight on until you see the sign for the exit of the Tanet-Gazon du Faing nature reserve. A little further down, you will find the intersection where you started. Continue downhill to the col du Calvaire.
