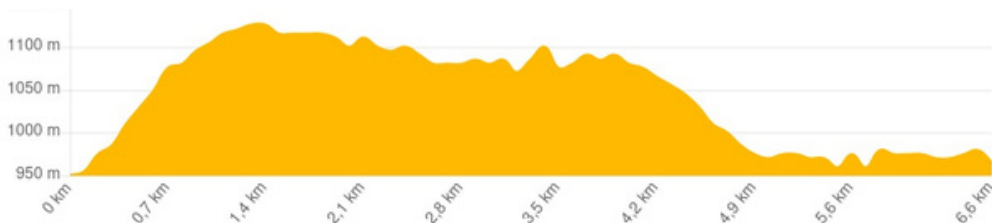
# FROM THE LAC NOIR TO THE LAC DES TRUITES

You may be familiar with the colourful duo tour, Blanc and Noir, which is relatively sporty. Opt for this new association which links the Lac Noir to the Lac des Truites. A very nice family tour, not too long and within everyone's reach to explore the lakes and enjoy exceptional views.

## DESCRIPTION

- 1 From the Lac Noir car park, cross the small bridge on your left. To the right of the monument, take the path that goes up (blue circle).
- 2 When the path leads to a wider track, follow it to the right (red circle). At the next crossroads, continue straight ahead with the same markings until you reach the lac des Truites.
- 3 Once you reach the foot of the lake, take the path immediately to the left before the dam (yellow circle). Continue straight on until you reach the Hautes-Huttes crossroads.
- 4 At the crossroads, keep to the left to continue on the wide marked path (yellow rectangle) towards the Lac Noir. Continue straight ahead until you reach the Lac Noir.



The Lac des Truites, located at an altitude of 1061m, is the highest lake in the Vosges mountains. Originally, it was called "Lac du Fœhrlé" which means "surrounded by small pines", then deformed to Forellen "trout" in German, it is now also known as "Lac du Forlet".
