Set off on an immersive walk in the footsteps of the soldiers who fought in the Battle of Woerth-Froeschwiller, also known as the 'Battle of Reichshoffen'. Discover the history of the soldiers on both sides, including the Turcos, Algerian riflemen serving in the French colonial army. This trail takes you to the heart of the tragic events of 6 August 1870 and back into a major chapter of history.

STEPS

1 From the car park to the monument of "Basse-Silésie"

The path soon takes you to the two memorials to the soldiers of "Basse-Silésie" : a tall yellow sandstone column and a pink sandstone rock topped by an eagle. Continue along the same path, passing a beautiful panorama of Woerth and its church towers.

2 From the monument to the soldiers of "Basse-Silésie" to the house of the Turcos

Continue your memorial trail in Alsace by entering the forest. You will again pass a monument to soldiers who died in the battle, but this time the graves are French. The route then joins a wide forest road heading north.

3 From the Turcos house to the car park

Walk past the ruins of the 'Maison des Turcos', the old house of Woerth's village guard. The route of this remembrance trail in Alsace then descends gently back to your starting point along a path through forests and orchards.
